Aim

To match each verb with three nouns and then make a present simple sentence with the verb and nouns using the correct subject-verb agreement.

Preparation

Make one copy of the worksheet for each student.

Level

Elementary (A1-A2)

Time

20 minutes

Introduction

Here is a subject-verb agreement worksheet to help teach students verb-noun collocations and subject-verb agreement in the present simple.

Procedure

Give each student a copy of the worksheet.

First, students match each verb on their worksheet with three nouns from the box.

Next, students write a present simple sentence for each verb using the given subject pronoun and three nouns.

When the students have finished, go through the answers with the class.
