Grammar and Speaking Game: answering questions (group work)

Focus

Question and answer structures

Aim

To practice a variety of question and answer structures.

Preparation

Two men's shirts. Make sure each shirt has the same amount of buttons down the front.

Level

Any

Time

15 minutes

Introduction

This fun Q and A game can be used to practice a variety of question and answer structures. You can also use the game in any situation where you want to elicit answers from students such as with flashcards.

Procedure

Divide the students into two teams.

One player from each team comes to the front of the class.

Give a man's shirt to each player.

Ask a question to the two players.

The two players then race to put on their shirt and button it up to the top.

The first player to button up their shirt gets to answer the question.

If the player answers the question correctly, they score a point for their team.

If the answer is incorrect, the other player buttons up their shirt and gets a chance to answer.

Then, two new players come to the front and so on.

The team with the most points at the end of the game wins.
