To answer questions

Two men's shirts

Introduction

This question and answer game can be used to practice language the students have studied in class. You can also use it to review question and answer structures, elicit answers from flashcards, etc.

Procedure

Divide the students into two teams.

One player from each team comes to the front of the class.

Give a man's shirt to each player. Make sure each shirt has the same amount of buttons down the front.

Ask a question to the two players.

The two players then race to put on their shirt and button it up to the top.

The first player to button up their shirt gets to answer the question.

If the player answers the question correctly, they score a point for their team.

If the answer is incorrect, the other player buttons up their shirt and gets a chance to answer.

Then, two new players come to the front and so on.

The team with the most points at the end of the game wins.
