Aim

To say things that you can see beginning with a certain letter.

Preparation

Level

Young learners

Time

10 minutes

Introduction

Here is a simple childhood word game many people used to play when they were younger.

Procedure

Have the students sit in a circle.

One student looks around and chooses something in the classroom or surrounding area, e.g. book.

The student then gives a clue to the chosen thing by saying, "I spy with my little eye, something beginning with B."

The other students then take it in turns to try to guess what it is.

When a student correctly guesses the word, they get to choose the next thing for the other students to guess.
