

### Activity Type

### Aim

To answer quiz questions

### Preparation

A list of questions

### Time

### Introduction

This is a strategic ESL quiz game for students of all ages.

### Procedure

Divide the students into three teams. Assign each team with a number 1 to 3.

Draw a five-by-five dotted grid on the board. Draw the dots about three inches apart so that they can be easily seen by the students.

Give a different coloured pen/chalk to each team.

Take it in turns to ask each team a quiz question.

If a team answers correctly, they connect two of the dots with a line either horizontally or vertically.

The aim of the game is to join the dots together to make squares.

When a team forms a square as a result of drawing a fourth line, they write their team's number in the square and have another turn.

The game is over when all 16 squares have been completed.

The team with the most squares wins the game.

You can increase or decrease the size of the grid to make the game quicker or slower, but the bigger the grid, the more questions you will need to ask.
