

## **Activity Type**

Speaking Activity: ordering, role-play, creating and presenting a dialogue, controlled and freer practice (pair work)

#### Focus

Shoe shopping

#### Aim

To practice shoe shopping phrases.

#### Preparation

Make one copy of the two worksheets for each pair of students.

Level

Pre-intermediate (A2)

### Time

25 minutes

### Introduction

In this shoe shop role-play activity, students put a shoe shop conversation in order and role-play a shoe shopping dialogue.

#### Procedure

Divide the students into pairs.

One student takes on the role of a shop assistant, and the other is a customer.

Give each student a corresponding worksheet.

Tell the students not to show their worksheet to their partner.

Students then put a shoe shop dialogue in the correct order by reading the sentences to each other and numbering them accordingly.

Afterwards, check the correct order with the class.

Exercise A - Answer key

- 1. Hi, can I help you?
- 2. Yes, please. I'm looking for a pair of shoes.

Next, students read the conversation in their pairs.

After that, pairs write their own shoe shop dialogue between a shop assistant and a customer using the phrases from the conversation.

Finally, pairs role-play their dialogues in front of the class.
