

Activity Type

Grammar, Vocabulary and Speaking Game: sentence completion (group work)

Focus

Coordinating conjunctions: *and, but, for, nor, or, so, yet*

Aim

To complete sentences that use coordinating conjunctions.

Preparation

Make one copy of the game board for each group of three. Enlarge the game board to A3 if possible. Also, provide a dice and counters for each group.

Level

Intermediate (B1)

Time

25 minutes

Introduction

In this conjunctions board game, students complete sentences that use the coordinating conjunctions: *and*, *but*, *for*, *nor*, *or*, *so*, *yet*.

Procedure

Divide the students into groups of three.

Give each group a copy of the game board, a dice and counters.

Explain that the students are going to complete sentences that use coordinating conjunctions and that each sentence must be different.

So, if a player lands on a square that a previous student has landed on, they must complete the sentence in a different way.

Remind the students that if there is a comma before the coordinating conjunction, the players must add an appropriate independent clause.

Players then place their counters on the start square.

The first player to throw a six starts the game.

Players take it in turns to roll the dice and move their counter along the board.

When a player lands on a square, they complete the sentence in a way that demonstrates the use of the coordinating conjunction in the sentence.

The player then says the sentence to the group for confirmation.

If the other students agree that the sentence is correct, the player stays on the square.

If not, the player goes back two squares.

The first player to reach the finish square wins the game.
