

# **Activity Type**

Vocabulary Game: miming, guessing (group work)

#### Focus

Action verbs

#### Aim

To play a board game where you perform, mime, or tell someone to do various actions described on cards.

### Preparation

Make one copy of the game board and action verb cards for each group of three or four. Cut the cards out as indicated. You will also need to prepare a dice and counters for each group.

### Level

Pre-intermediate (A2)

#### Time

30 minutes

## Introduction

In this entertaining action verbs board game, students perform, mime, or tell someone to do various actions described on cards.

#### Procedure

Divide the students into groups of three or four.

Give each group a copy of the board game, a set of action verb cards, a dice and counters.

Ask the students to shuffle the cards and place them face-down in a pile on the game board.

Players place their counters on the start square.

Players then take it in turns to roll the dice and move their counter along the board.

When a player lands on a 'Do an action' square, they pick up the top card from the pile and place it face-up for everyone to see.

The player then performs the action described on the card. If the action is correct, they remain on the square. If not, they go back one square.

If a player lands on a 'Tell someone to do an action' square, they pick up the top card from the pile and tell another player to do the action on the card.

If the selected player does the correct action, the (selected) player stays on their square. If not, the selected player moves their counter back one space.

When a player lands on a 'Mime an action' square, that player picks up a card and mimes the action on the card for the other players to guess.

For example, if the player picks up the card 'clap your hands', they mime the action to the other students.

If another student correctly guesses the verb (e.g. clap), the player stays on the square. If the action verb isn't guessed correctly, the player moves back a square.

When a card has been used, it is placed back at the bottom of the pile.

The first player to reach the finish wins the game.
