

Activity Type

Reading, writing, listening and speaking breakout room activity, pairwork

Language Focus

Present perfect with 'just' and 'yet'

Aim

To make sentences and questions with 'just' and 'yet'.

Preparation

Send each student a copy of the interactive worksheet.

Level

Elementary (A1-A2)

Time

25 minutes

Introduction

This interactive present perfect breakout room activity helps to teach students how to use 'just' and 'yet'.

Procedure

Students begin by writing down five sentences about things they have just done and five sentences about things they plan to do today but haven't done yet.

When the students have finished writing, divide them into pairs and put them in breakout rooms.

Explain that the students are going to guess what sentences their partner wrote down.

The students then guess and write down three things their partner has just done and three things their partner hasn't done yet today.

After that, students ask and answer questions with their partner to see if their guesses were right or wrong.
