Language Focus

Holiday vocabulary

Going to

Present continuous

Aim

To ask and answer questions about holiday plans.

Preparation

Send each student a corresponding A or B interactive worksheet.

Level

Elementary (A1-A2)

Time

25 minutes

Introduction

Here is an interactive holiday plans breakout room activity to help teach students how to ask and answer questions about holiday plans.

Procedure

Divide the students into pairs (A and B) and put them in breakout rooms.

Send each student a corresponding A or B worksheet.

Go through the categories on the worksheet and elicit the questions the students need to ask.

Example: Justin

Holiday destination: Where is Justin going on holiday?

Transportation: How is he getting there?

Departure date: When is he leaving?

Length of stay: How long is he going to stay there?

Accommodation: Where is he going to stay?

Planned activities: What is he planning to do?

In their pairs, the students then complete the missing information about the four people's holiday plans by asking and answering questions with 'going to' and the present continuous.

When the students have finished, they check their answers.

Students then use the six questions to ask their partner about their holiday plans.
