

Activity Type

Writing, listening and speaking breakout room activity, group work

Language Focus

'be going to' for future intentions

Aim

To practice 'be going to' for future intentions.

Preparation

Send each student a copy of the interactive worksheet.

Level

Pre-intermediate (A2)

Time

30 minutes

Introduction

In this interactive 'be going to' breakout room activity, students talk about future intentions by discussing ways to improve their English.

Procedure

Tell the students to think about how they could improve their English skills. The students then write down three ideas for each category.

When the students have finished, divide them into groups of four and put them in breakout rooms.

The students then discuss their ideas and choose the six best things that they are going to do to improve their English.

The students choose one idea from each category and write a sentence with 'be going to', e.g. 'I'm going to speak English for one hour a day'.

When the students have finished, find out which were the most popular ideas by getting feedback from each group, and see which students intend to try the ideas they wrote down.
