### Focus

Ordinal numbers

Months

Dates

### Aim

To practice saying ordinal  
numbers, months and  
dates.

### Preparation

Make one copy of the  
worksheet for each pair  
of students and cut as  
indicated.

### Level

Elementary (A1-A2)

### Time

15 minutes

### Introduction

In this saying dates activity, students practice ordinal numbers, months and dates.

### Procedure

Divide the students into pairs (Student A and B).

Give each student a corresponding worksheet.

Students then take turns asking questions to fill in the missing dates in a table, completing it with their partner's answers.

Example:

Q: What's the date in square A1?

A: It's the 3rd of March.

When the students have finished, they check their answers and spelling by comparing worksheets with their partner.
