### Aim

To learn and practice present simple 'Wh' questions and question words.

### Preparation

Send each student a copy of the interactive worksheet.

### Level

Elementary (A1-A2)

### Time

20 minutes

### Introduction

This interactive worksheet helps students learn and practice present simple 'Wh' questions and question words.

### Procedure

Students begin by matching each question word with its correct usage.

Exercise A - Answer key

1. d, 2. h, 3. a, 4. b, 5. c, 6. g, 7. f, 8. e

Students then complete present simple questions with a suitable question word.

Exercise B - Answer key

1. Where	4. Where	7. Whose	10. Why

Next, students sort the questions into the correct columns, according to their grammatical form.

Exercise C - Answer key
