Speaking Activity: asking and answering questions, guided discussion, freer practice (group work)

Focus

Weather

Aim

To practice talking about the weather.

Preparation

Make one copy of the cards for each group of three or four and cut as indicated.

Level

Upper-intermediate (B2)

Time

30 minutes

Introduction

Here is a weather conversation questions activity to help students practice talking about the weather.

Procedure

Divide the students into groups of three or four.

Give each group a set of cards.

Ask the students to shuffle the cards and place them face-down in a pile on the table.

Students then take it in turns to pick up a card and ask the other students in their group the weather conversation question on the card.

Each student responds to the question in turn and the students then discuss the weather topic.

Encourage the students to ask follow-up questions when possible.

Be on hand to clarify any difficult words, phrases or questions, e.g. weather patterns, traditions, etc.

When the students have finished, go through the questions on the cards and get feedback from around the class.

Any interesting findings can then be discussed in more detail.
