

### Activity Type

Reading, listening and speaking breakout room activity, pairwork

### Language Focus

Gerunds and infinitives

### Aim

To answer questions with gerunds and infinitives.

### Preparation

Send each student a corresponding A or B interactive worksheet.

### Level

Intermediate (A2-B1)

### Time

20 minutes

### Introduction

Here is an interactive discussion breakout room activity to help students practice gerunds and infinitives.

### Procedure

Divide the students into pairs (A and B) and put them in breakout rooms.

Send each student a corresponding A or B worksheet.

Student A starts by asking Student B to tell him or her about the things listed on the worksheet, e.g. 'Tell me about something you want to do in the future'.

Each response Student B gives requires a gerund or infinitive in the answer.

To keep the conversation going, Student A is encouraged to ask follow-up questions where possible.

When all the questions have been asked, the students swap roles.

Afterwards, students give feedback to the class on what they found out about their partner.
