

### Activity Type

Interactive reading and writing exercise

### Language Focus

Verbs and their opposites

### Aim

To practice verbs and their opposites.

### Preparation

Send each student a copy of the interactive worksheet.

### Level

Elementary (A1-A2)

### Time

15 minutes

### Introduction

This interactive worksheet helps to increase students' knowledge of verbs and their opposites.

### Procedure

Students look at the verbs on the worksheet and write the opposite of each verb in the space provided.

When the students have finished, go through the correct answers.

Students score one point for each correct opposite. The student with the most points at the end wins.
