Vocabulary and Grammar Exercises: rewriting sentences

## **Focus**

Adjective order

## Aim

To rewrite sentences, adding in adjectives in the correct order.

# Preparation

Make one copy of the worksheet for each student.

### Level

Intermediate (B1)

#### Time

20 minutes

## Introduction

This adjective order worksheet helps students to practice the order of adjectives.

#### **Procedure**

Give each student a copy of the worksheet.

Go through the introduction on the worksheet.

Then, review adjective order with the class by writing the following sentences on the board and having the students add in the adjectives in the correct order.

- 1. We took a ride on a bus. (Chinese, blue, old)
- 2. My brother rode a horse in the parade. (big, black, beautiful)

Answer key

- 1. We took a ride on an old, blue, Chinese bus.
- 2. My brother rode a beautiful, big, black horse in the parade.

Students then use the chart on the worksheet to help them rewrite the 10 sentences with the adjectives in brackets in the correct order.

Finally, check the correct answers with the class.

#### Answer key

- 2. a new, horror film
- 3. a sexy, short, red dress
- 4. a long, narrow street

- 6. a delicious, hot meal
- 7. with long, straight, blonde hair
