Grammar and Speaking Game: forming and asking questions from prompts (group work)

Focus

Wh questions

Aim

To create *Wh* questions from answers.

Preparation

Prepare a list of answers for *Wh* questions you want to review.

Level

Pre-intermediate (A2)

Time

20 minutes

Introduction

In this *Wh* questions game, students race to make questions from answers.

Procedure

Explain that the students are going to play a game where they are given an answer and have to race to come up with the correct *Wh* question.

Give the students an example answer, e.g. 'I normally arrive home at 6 p.m.'

Elicit the correct question from the class, i.e. 'What time do you normally arrive home?'

Next, divide the class into two teams.

Choose one player from each team to come to the front of the class.

Have the two players stand side-by-side.

Read an answer to a question and ask the two players 'What's the question?'

The first player to respond with the correct question scores a point for their team.

Two new players then come to the front of the class, and so on.

The team with the most points at the end of the game wins.
